Meeting Gatsby Benchmarks

We work with each of our partner schools and colleges to develop a tailored programme of careers education activities which runs throughout the academic year.

All of our programmes are supported by "live" business volunteers.

Set out below is how we can help you meet a number of Gatsby benchmarks:

Gatsby one: A stable careers programme;

We provide bookable slots throughout the academic year which enables you to incorporate our events into your academic year plan.

Gatsby three: Addressing the needs of each student;

we have ensured that we provide a wide range of employability events and activities that are suited to each year's group. We can also provide adjustments to students with SEND or language barriers.

Gatsby two:

Careers and labour market information;

our partnership with "live" business volunteers coupled with fun and interactive sessions such as "speedy speakers" helps students to gain an insight into real life jobs and employers, including the skills and training routes needed to succeed in a career.

Gatsby five:

Encounters with employers and employees;

we work with hundreds of real "live" business volunteers from across the Leicestershire Sector – with that comes a vast wealth of work experience and insider knowledge that they are happy to share with students.



Employability workshops

Employability activities last from as little as 20 minutes to 2 hours

Speedy Speakers

We will provide up to three volunteers from different sectors. Each volunteer will give a three to five minute career talk to assemblies or classes of students, followed by a Q&A session.

Guess My Job

We will provide up to three volunteers for each event. Students in whole year assemblies or classes ask questions to business volunteers in order to find out what their job is. This encourages students to think about what they value in a career and learn about lots of different types of industries and jobs.

CV Workshops

We will recruit up to four business volunteers per session. Volunteers will do a short introduction about what a CV is and what makes a good CV. Students will then work through CV activities supported by employers, with a short Q&A session to finish.

Workplace skills and Behaviours Workshop

We will provide up to four business volunteers who will each talk to students about skills and behaviours that employers expect in their workplace, finishing with a short Q&A.



Interview skills

All students will receive a mock interview with a business volunteer followed by both verbal and written feedback. In addition, all students will receive a certificate and the chance to be presented with a star certificate for outstanding effort.


